- (b) All Passengers who Embarked at Ports in EUROPE should be excluded from this schedule and included in the fourth schedule.
- (c) In the case of those ships engaged in pleasure cruises starting and ending in the UNITED KINGDOM, the full particulars required by this form should be furnished only in respect of those passengers who embark out of EUROPE and disembark in the UNITED KINGDOM.
- (d) Passengers in each class of accommodation should be entered in separate groups.
