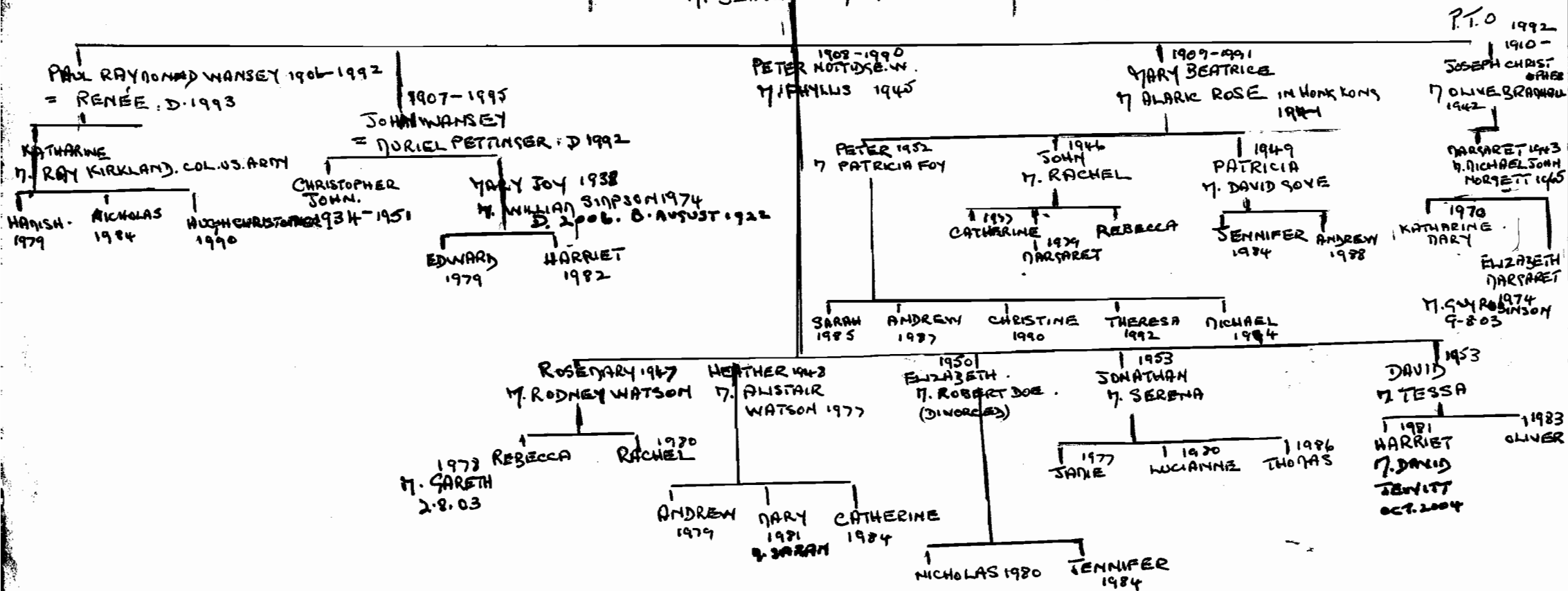

M. BEATRICE MARGARETTA NOTTIDGE D 1924

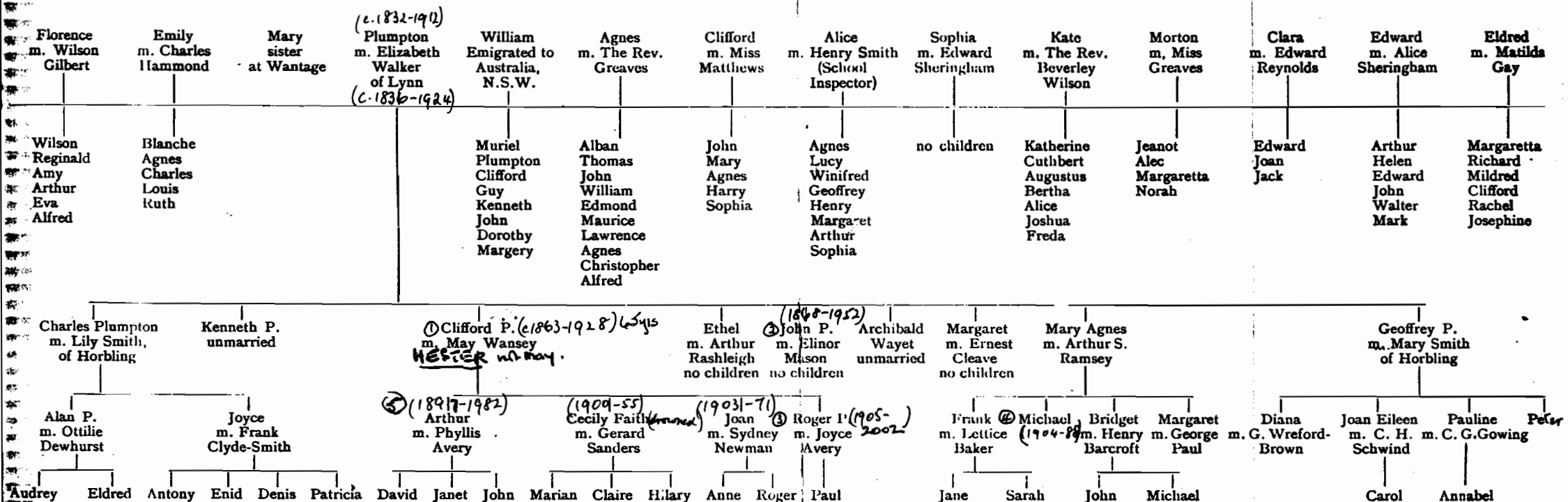

PEDIGREE OF THE WILSON FAMILY.

ELDRED DE PLOMPTON held lands just after the Conquest.

NIGEL DE PLOMPTON held the whole lordship about A.D. 1195.

SIR — DE PLOMPTON, a Knight Templar has a monument in the Irish Church of Snoffard.

SIR PETER DE PLOMPTON engaged in the Barons war against King John about 1200 A.D.

SIR WILLIAM DE PLOMPTON married a daughter of Mowbray.

SIR ROBERT DE PLOMPTON married Lucy, daughter of William, Lord Ross.

SIR WILLIAM DE PLOMPTON, son of the first Sir William, married Alice, daughter of — Guisborough.

SIR ROBERT DE PLOMPTON, brother of Sir William, was knighted by Edward III about 1335 and married Isabel, daughter of Lord Scroope and sister of Richard Scroope, Archbishop of York.

SIR WILLIAM DE PLOMPTON, son of Sir Robert, was beheaded with his uncle the Archbishop and several others at York for rebellion against Henry IV, 1406.

SIR ROBERT DE PLOMPTON was in the army of John, Duke of Bedford, Regent of France, 1424.

SIR WILLIAM DE P., his son, married Catherine, daughter of Thomas Wintringham, of Knareborough. A steady adherent of Edward IV, amongst other honours he got permission to castellate his house at Plumpton and to have free warren of all lands in that manor.

SIR WILLIAM DE P. married (1) Isabel, daughter of Robert Babthorpe. (2) Elizabeth, eldest daughter of Lord Clifford, she was first married to his younger brother Clifford at the age of 7 and on his death to his elder brother William.

ROBERT PLOMPTON, only son of above married Ann Norton of Norton and died before his father.

WILLIAM PLOMPTON, his only son married (1) Mary, daughter of Sir William Vavasour.
(2) Ann, daughter of Edward Griffin, of Dingley.

SIR EDWARD PLOMPTON, his only son married Frances Ardington of Ardington, Lancs, by whom he had 10 sons and 5 daughters : 2 sons survived.

From SIR JOHN come the Plumptons of Plumpton.

From Edward, 2nd son, the Plumptons of Snaith.
