## FORSTER-FAIRBAIRN PAIRS

The four heats in the first round of the Forster-Fairbairn junior pairs were decided at Cambridge yesterday. Some very good racing was seen and Selwyn equalled last year's winning time in the final, returned by the Trinity Hall pair, J. E. Gilmour, the Blue, who was partnered by J. L. Brockhouse. Selwyn thus came within two seconds of the record for this event, set up by H. R. N. Rickett and W. A. Prideaux in 1929. Details:

HEAT D.—Christ's (E. S. Reed (Monkton Combe, and B. J. R. Roberts, St. Paul's) bt Lady Margaret (R. C. Harman (Oundle, and J. H. Faulkner, Shrewsbury) by 5sec. 8m 15sec.
