Lancaster within our Diocese and Jurisdiction, did before his *collation*
and Institution thereto, in Our presence make and subscribe the Declarations of
Assent and against Simony, and take the Oath of Allegiance as by law provided,
and also take the Oath of canonical obedience to Us and Our successors, Bishops
of Manchester, in all things lawful and honest.

February — in the year of our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and
forty-two —, in the *twenty-third* year of Our Consecration
