Institute you in and to the said *Rectory* ———— and invest you with all and singular the
Rights, Members, and Appurtenances thereunto belonging (You having first in our presence made
and subscribed the Declarations, and taken the Oaths as are by Canon law or Statute in such
cases required to be made, subscribed and taken). **And we do** by these presents commit unto
you the Cure and Government of the Souls of the Parishioners of the said Parish, and authorise
you to preach the Word of God in the Parish Church of *Woodford* ————
aforesaid. **Saving** always to ourselves and our successors our Episcopal Rights, and the Dignity
and Honour of our Cathedral Church of *Chelmsford*.
