

taken). And we do by these presents commit unto you the Cure and Government of the Souls
of the Parishioners of the said Parish, and authorise you to preach the Word of God in the
Parish Church of _ Roydon aforesaid. Saving always
to ourselves and our successors our Episcopal Rights, and the Dignity and Honour of our
Cathedral Church of - Chelmsford .
