We are in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant and have pleasure in sending you herewith a copy of the General Guide to Swiss Hotels, giving details of establishments at the principal resorts, also a copy of the North-Eastern Switzerland Regional Hotel List, in which you will find given details of establishments at smaller resorts and establishments in that area. Likewise enclosed is a copy of our railway/postal motor route map of Switzerland which we trust will meet with your requirements.

The cheapest and best ticket available for travel in Switzerland is the Swiss Holiday Ticket, referred to in the map. Such tickets are issued for pre-determined return or circular itineraries commencing and ending at Swiss Frontier or Airport Stations and also contain five control squares enabling the holder to purchase in Switzerland additional excursions at half-fare. If you will kindly communicate with us again when your plans have matured, stating the itinerary you wish to cover and class of travel required, we shall be pleased to quote you.

The Official Swiss Timetable contains all the railway, lake-steamers and postal motor services in operation throughout Switzerland. Supplies of the summer 1964 edition of this timetable, which comes into operation on May 31st, are expected to reach us from Switzerland about the middle of May. The price of the timetable is 7/- and if you care to let us have a remittance for this amount we shall be pleased to forward you a copy as soon as they are available.
